Preservation South Carolina (PSC) is pleased to accept forms for endangered historic properties across the state. The purpose of this form is to identify vulnerable historic properties for potential investment, while advocating and encouraging for their preservation.

It is our mission to preserve and protect South Carolina's historic buildings and places, advocating for their productive use, and promoting the state's diverse cultural legacy.

Generally, our projects are listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places, although it is not required. Find information about historic buildings in the South Carolina Historic Properties Record and SC ArchSite. Forms are accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year. We will reply to your submission within 60 days.

Form Submission

Form Checklist: Incomplete forms will not be considered. A complete form MUST include:

- One copy of the Historic Endangered Property Form with all data and information fields filled (and Building Owner if different from the Applicant).
- Additional documentation
 - o Images:
 - ➤ Digital photographs must include overall views of the exterior and interior of the building, as well as detailed photographs of the damage to be repaired. Up to 15 may be saved in a PDF document and submitted via email. Within the document, label each with location, image number, and number each page.
 - ➤ Other images such as building floor plans, elevations, and site maps are encouraged, also send in a PDF via email.

Forms must be submitted electronically. (Please save and retain a copy of your form).

Forms received on a rolling basis throughout the year.
